




Message from the Vicar...

Greetings in the name of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ

Our church is entering into an important liturgical season this month. The Great Lent (ValiyaNombu) begins on 3rd March. It will culminate with Easter. Observing the Lent means we are in a process of transformation through disciplining ourselves in both physical and spiritual way. To achieve this transformation believers may fast, say timely prayers, abstain from the worldly pleasures, avoid certain kind of foods, set apart an amount from their earnings to support the needy, repentance of sins and giving up certain luxuries as a form of penance. In short Lent denotes a change in the inner being of a believer.

Lent is a season for deepening our spiritual life through the means of sanctification offered to us by the Church: through prayer, giving and fasting. At the base of everything is the word of God, which during this season we are invited to hear and ponder more deeply. Let us consider the parable of the rich man and Lazarus (Lk 16:19-31). We find an inspiration in this meaningful story, for it provides a key to understanding what we need to do in order to attain true happiness and eternal life.

Great Lent is the sacred time to remember and thank God for His son Jesus Christ who carried the burden of sin and suffering.

As a parish let's prepare for the Lent with prayers, reading of the scripture and sharing the love to the people around.

This Lent, let us prepare ourselves to pray ... a little bit more, to give ... a little bit more, and to hear ... a little bit more, to the voice of those who cry out and let these cries, trouble our conscience and make us a Christian with a difference.

I take this opportunity to sincerely thank the office bearers and executive committee of 2018 -19 for their sacrificial work and service. May the Lord Almighty bless them for their efforts. I welcome the 2019 - 20 office bearers. Let us work together for the glory of the God.


